Access Information: Make certain Santa has all the security information, if you live in a gated community—whether this is a pass code or Santa's name at the front gate.

Pets: If there are any pets who might be over-excited by a big guy in a fur-trimmed suit (with bells on!), it might be best for them to relax elsewhere, such as in a closed room.

Giving Out Gifts: If Santa is distributing the gifts you are providing, he might need a helper or two. This is a good job for teens and those folks who know everyone. Remember: If there are more gifts than Santa can carry, please send a helper.

Special Audience Members: If there are any people with Special Needs, make certain Santa knows. When children are present, there must always be an adult serving as the child wrangler who will remain with Santa at all times.

Sugar and Candy Canes: Please let Santa know if there are any special issues before he offers to hand out candy canes.
